

# Backyard / Nature Walk Scavenger Hunt

Explore the outdoors with 4 senses. **See It, Feel It, Smell It, Hear It.**

<p>Search for something that moves on its own. How does it move? Can you replicate its movement?</p>	<p>Look for animal tracks! Determine the direction the animal was walking in. What kind of animal do you think it is?</p>	<p>Search for a four-leaf Clover.</p>	<p>Find 2 different tree seeds – acorns, pinecones, nuts, pods, or even winged seeds! Discuss how they travel and how they grow.</p>
<p>Find a smooth surface that feels nice to touch. How / why is it smooth?</p>	<p>Touch a crunchy leaf. Touch a green leaf! What makes them feel the way they do?</p>	<p>Close your eyes and experience the weather. What do you feel? The chill of wind, the warmth of sun, the coolness of clouds passing overhead.</p>	<p>Collect a variety of objects to do a nature rub: rough, smooth, leaves, sticks, anything textured.</p>
<p>Smell a blooming flower.</p>	<p>Smell the bark of 2 different trees. How do they compare? What makes them different?</p>	<p>Find a patch of really green grass. Describe how it smells!</p>	<p>Smell mud! Smell dirt! Describe the difference.</p>
<p>Find something that snaps!</p>	<p>Listen to a singing bird. Can you repeat its song? Can you find where they are singing from?</p>	<p>Search for something that you can make music with. Why does it make a sound? Explore your object!</p>	<p>Close your eyes and name as many sounds as you can. What do you recognize? What sounds unfamiliar?</p>
